Information for Families

Foundations for Success is a therapeutic classroom developed by the Natrona County School District in partnership with Wyoming Behavioral Institute. This specialized learning environment can help students in kindergarten through 2nd grade who are struggling emotionally and behaviorally in the school setting.

Under the direction of trained mental health professionals, the Foundations for Success Program works together with each child's traditional elementary school to help the student achieve personal goals and become more successful in the classroom. Our goal is to have our students back to their home schools full-time within a year.

Children have the opportunity to participate in a variety of therapeutic activities including:

- Social skills groups
- Emotion regulation groups
- Relaxation groups
- Expressive arts activities
- Individual therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Family therapy

We believe family involvement is critical for students to succeed. Family involvement is encouraged through:

- Daily updates
- Weekly contacts by phone or in person
- Monthly meetings with the student's school team
- Family nights
- Access to a parent library
- Educational resources
